community to experience the sacredness of Christ's presence.


- (1) Bulletin : we have evolved from printed bulletins to e-bulletins.

- (2) Canteen : you will be pleased to know that our Canteen will be  
resuming operations from 5 June from 8.30 am to 11 am. Free  
coffee/tea and biscuits will be offered for a start to enable us to  
catch-up with each other. Please bear with us as we are  
looking for more help to start Canteen operations.
- (3) Holy Hour : we will resume First Friday Holy Hour at 8 pm in the  
main Church. We will continue with the theme on "The  
Beatitudes". Come and join us.
- (4) Resumption of Face-to-Face Classes : various classes will start  
to resume and those involved will be notified.

If the Masses are more than 500 pax, all must be fully vaccinated.


For Masses that are capped at 500, the Parish cannot exceed this number.
