VISION FOR CATECHESIS (Pre-school/Children/Youth)

Catechesis is not just about sacramental preparation for Baptism, Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation; it seeks to put the person not only in touch but in an intimate communion with Jesus Christ (Pope John Paul II on Catechesis in Our Time (CT), #5) so that as a disciple of Christ, one becomes more like Him (CT 20).

The role of the catechist, assistant and facilitator then is as a 'steward of the mystery' (1 Cor 4:1), facilitating the candidate's encounter with Jesus and His Church as there is 'only one Teacher, the Christ.' (Mt 23:10).

The catechist's goal always is to set hearts aflame for Christ.
