From the Desk of the Parish Priest

Preparations for our 180th Anniversary Celebrations

Time really flies! Our parish celebrated its 175th Anniversary in 2021 and now we are planning our 180th Anniversary!

Aligning with our 180th Anniversary theme, “St Joseph: Model of All Who Work”, we would like to share with you our rich Church history and how we have evolved from a wooden chapel established by French missionaries in Kranji in 1846 to its modern multicultural community of worshippers, laity groups, schools, seminary and theological institute.

Over 18 months beginning from December 2024 to May 2026, we will publish monthly articles on how missionaries from the Paris Foreign Missions or Missions Étrangères de Paris (MEP) left their legacy with us, such as the tombstone of Fr Anatole Mauduit (founder of our church), the statue of St Joseph (which came from Paris), the religious congregations of the Brothers of St Gabriel and the Infant Jesus Sisters (brought in by MEP) and the St Francis Xavier Major Seminary (which evolved from the Minor Seminary established by MEP priests).

Some articles highlight the early harsh local environment faced by MEP priests, the outposts of our parish, local priests who helped to develop our parish, our diverse lay communities and our parish census. Other articles examine how our parish has been blessed with the Chapel of the Resurrection, the Stations of the Cross, the Rosary Garden, St Joseph's Garden, the Community Hall precinct, the Catholic Theological Institute of Singapore, the stained-glass pieces in our church and our historical artefacts.

The articles will be compiled into an anniversary publication in 2026. We hope that you will enjoy the articles and appreciate the contributions of various people over the decades. Peter Ling from the Lector Ministry and Guest Editor of The Carpenter Newsletter will be writing the monthly articles.

May God and our Patron St Joseph continue to guide the physical and spiritual growth of our parish.

Dear Parents

As Catholic parents, it is our privilege and duty to nurture our children's faith. While Catholic schools provide a foundation in Catholic values, sacramental preparation is a parent's responsibility.

We invite you to register your children for Catechism at our Church, where they will receive guidance and preparation for the Sacraments.

- For Pre-primary children, you can inquire and register with the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd before 31 Oct.
- For Primary level children, you will need to register for Primary Catechesis as we will prepare them for the Sacrament of Reconciliation (at Year 2) and the Sacrament of First Holy Communion (at Year 3).
- For Secondary teens, they will be prepared for the Sacrament of Confirmation by our catechists and facilitators.

We encourage you to enroll your children in Catechism and consider joining the Catechetical Ministry yourself. This journey is a wonderful opportunity to deepen your own faith while supporting your child's spiritual growth. Let's work together to foster a lifelong connection with God!






