The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (in latin : Corpus Christi) is celebrated to honour the real presence of the body (corpus) of Jesus Christ in the bread and wine of the Eucharist, which is the centre of our faith, and the summit of our belief.

On this Feast Day,

- the Extra-Ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) will renew their commitment and pledge at the Sunset Mass;
- the children will receive their First Holy Communion at the 5.30 pm Mass on Sunday; and
- to celebrate this important feast, we will have the traditional procession of Corpus Christi after the 5.30 pm Mass.



Preparation for Consecration to St Joseph



PREPARATION FOR CONSECRATION TO ST. JOSEPH

Total consecration to St. Joseph is a formal act of filial entrustment to him as our spiritual father so that he can take care of our spiritual well-being and lead us to God. The act of consecration of oneself to St. Joseph reveals that we give our hearts to Joseph, so that uniting our hearts to that of St. Joseph will teach us how to love Jesus totally with a father's heart. This preparation programme is modelled and adapted from St. Louis Marie de Montfort's tried-and-tested 33-day preparation method in his Marian consecration. The end goal of all devotion and consecration is the total giving of oneself to Jesus Christ.
