Mark your calendars and come together with us to deepen our understanding of God's Word and strengthen our bonds as a community.

Major seminary in our parish

Did you know that St Joseph’s Church in Bukit Timah (SJCCT) has had two seminaries in its history? The first was the Redemptorist Major Seminary between 1972-1974 in what is now the Montfort Centre (the seminary was then shifted to Bangalore in India). The second is the St Francis Xavier Major Seminary (SFXMS) since 2018.

The history of SFXMS can be divided into pre-1983 and post-1983. Before 1983, seminarians studied at the St Francis Xavier Minor Seminary, which was established in 1925 at the Church of Our Lady of the Nativity in Upper Serangoon by Bishop Emile Barillon from the Missions Étrangères de Paris (MEP). Seminarians studied in Latin for four years at the Minor Seminary and moved on to advanced priestly studies at the College General in Penang, Malaya.

College General or its other name of Seminary of the Holy Angels started in Penang in 1808 as a legacy of MEP, which had shifted its regional seminary locations from Thailand to Cambodia to India and then to Malaya for reasons of political stability and geographical convenience. In the early 1850s, Fr Claude Tisserand from College General started a Minor Seminary in Singapore, St Mary’s College, but this was discontinued after a year when he built a new seminary building near schools in Penang.

A major contributor to the St Francis Xavier Minor Seminary in Singapore was Fr Pierre Barthoulot, who was Rector for 22 years between 1949-1971. He was dubbed ‘The Maker of Priests’ as he mentored several prominent priests – Archbishop Nicholas Chia, Msgr Ambrose Vaz, Msgr Francis Lau, Fr Cyril Lee, Fr Noel Chin, Fr Paul Goh, and Fr Robert Balhetchet. Fr Gregory Yong, later the Archbishop of Singapore, had assisted Fr Barthoulot for eight years.

Sending seminarians to Penang had its problems in the 1960s and 1970s. Malaysia had a quota on foreign missionaries and Singapore seminarians were classified as missionaries because College General was not an institution of higher learning. In 1983, Archbishop Gregory Yong decided to have a Major Seminary in Singapore, with Fr Noel Chin as Rector.

After 1983, the Major Seminary also had several

location changes. During construction of the Major Seminary in Punggol, the Major Seminary used the premises of the Minor Seminary in Upper Serangoon Road. In 1988, Archbishop Yong blessed and opened the Punggol Seminary. Between 2005-2013, then Fr William Goh became the first alumnus of the Major Seminary to be Rector. In 2015, the Major Seminary was housed at St Teresa’s Church while construction took place in SJCCT for a bigger building to house both the Major Seminary and the Catholic Theological Institute of Singapore (CTIS).

In 2018, Archbishop William Goh blessed the Major Seminary building. In 2019, a time capsule to preserve the Major Seminary’s legacy was installed, to be opened in 2069.

Seminarians at the Major Seminary, which was affiliated to the Pontifical Urbania University in Rome in 2007, study in English for eight years: 1st Year Initiation Year cover Church Latin, Salvation History, Christian Spirituality and Personal Growth & Development; 2nd-3rd Years of Philosophy Studies include Scripture, Metaphysics, Epistemology, Logic, Hebrew, Greek, History of Philosophy and Moral Philosophy; 4th Year is usually an attachment to a parish; and 5th-8th Years of Theology Studies offer Scripture, Liturgy, Church History, Dogmatic Theology, Sacramental Theology and Canon Law.

The seminary over the years has produced local shepherds who have been familiar faces in SJCCT, for example, SFXMS Rector Fr Valerian Cheong, CTIS Rector Msgr James Yeo, Fr Christopher Lee, Msgr Peter Zhang, Fr Joseph Zhang and Fr Edward Seah. Students have also come from ASEAN, China, East Timor, Hong Kong, Macao and Mexico.

We pray that the Major Seminary will continue to be the ‘Maker of Priests’ now and in the future.

Preparation for Consecration to St Joseph



PREPARATION FOR CONSECRATION TO ST. JOSEPH

Total consecration to St. Joseph is a formal act of filial entrustment to him as our spiritual father so that he can take care of our spiritual well-being and lead us to God. The act of consecration of oneself to St. Joseph reveals that we give our hearts to Joseph, so that uniting our hearts to that of St. Joseph will teach us how to love Jesus totally with a father's heart. This preparation programme is modelled and adapted from St. Louis Marie de Montfort's tried-and-tested 33-day preparation method in his Marian consecration. The end goal of all devotion and consecration is the total giving of oneself to Jesus Christ.




