Partnering religious congregations

Our parish has been closely connected with two religious congregations to cater to the educational needs of our faithful in Bukit Timah: The Montfort Brothers of St Gabriel and the Infant Jesus Sisters.

The Montfort Brothers of St Gabriel trace its origins to French priest St Louis Marie de Montfort, who lived between 1673-1716. St Montfort provided education for needy children and entrusted his mission to the Brothers assisting him.

In 1931, Bishop Adrien Devals from Missions Étrangères de Paris (MEP) invited the Brothers to Malaya and Singapore as he was highly impressed with their educational standards in Bangkok.

The Brothers arrived in Singapore in 1936 and took over the Holy Innocents English School. Our parish offered mission land along Bukit Timah Road to the Brothers to start the St Joseph Trade School in 1938. The Brothers then established Boys Town, Assumption English School, Assumption Pathway School and Montfort Centre on church grounds, plus Montfort Junior School, Montfort Secondary School, St Gabriel's Primary School and St Gabriel's Secondary School in various parts of Singapore. In 2001, the Brothers incorporated St Gabriel's Foundation to administer their institutions and schools in Singapore.

The Gabrielite schools have produced many priests, among them Archbishop Nicholas Chia and Cardinal William Goh. The Brothers have touched the lives of many people: the late Bro Emmanuel, who was in Singapore between 1954-2017, was involved in the Parish Pastoral Council, SJC Kindergarten and faith formation ministries; and Bro Roger Venne, aged 96, came to Singapore in 1953 to start a Tailoring Section and look after the Boys Town dorm, has been active in parish RCIA and has a vast collection of photographs of our church and its surroundings.

The Infant Jesus Sisters (IJ Sisters) also had French heritage. French priest Blessed Nicholas Barre founded an institute to provide education for girls living in poverty in the 17th century.

The IJ Sisters presence in Singapore owe much to Fr

Jean-Marie Beurel, who believed in education for spiritual growth. Impressed with the education provided by John Baptist de la Salle schools for boys and the Infant Jesus Sisters schools for girls, he met the Father General and Mother General of the two congregations in Paris in 1851 and invited them to launch similar schools in Singapore. Four IJ Sisters, including the pioneering Mother Mathilde Raclot, arrived in Singapore in 1854 to launch the Convent of the Holy Infant Jesus (CHIJ) at Victoria Street.

The IJ Sisters came to Bukit Timah in the mid-1950s. Fr Joachim Teng, who had built a new building for the St Joseph's Sino-English School in 1953, realised that there was a need for an English school for girls and approached Mother Charles, Provincial of the Infant Jesus Sisters.

For two years, the IJ Sisters held classes in the afternoons at St Joseph's Sino-English School while their building on parish land at Chestnut Drive was under construction. In 1955, the Convent of the Holy Infant Jesus Bukit Timah was officially founded. It became the eighth CHIJ school in Singapore with 62 pupils. Between 2005-2007, construction began on a new campus at Chestnut Drive and in 2007, the convent was renamed CHIJ Our Lady Queen of Peace. Archbishop Nicholas Chia blessed the new convent on 6 July 2007.

The IJ Sisters' presence in our parish extended beyond education. Recognising the changing social needs of Singapore, the Sisters established Girls' Town in 1968 in the same school compound. This innovative residential care model provided a family-like environment for older girls from the orphanage in Victoria Street.

The IJ Sisters, who celebrated its 170th Anniversary in 2024 in Singapore, have been parish partners for seven decades. They have contributed to the Parish Pastoral Council, faith formation and catechetical ministries. They have also provided accommodation and hospitality during church renovations.
