Grant that we, redeemed by the cross of Christ, may behold His glory in the world's vulnerable and afflicted, and serve them with compassionate love.



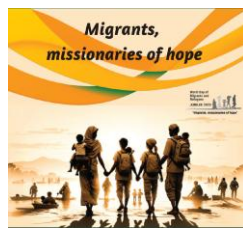
